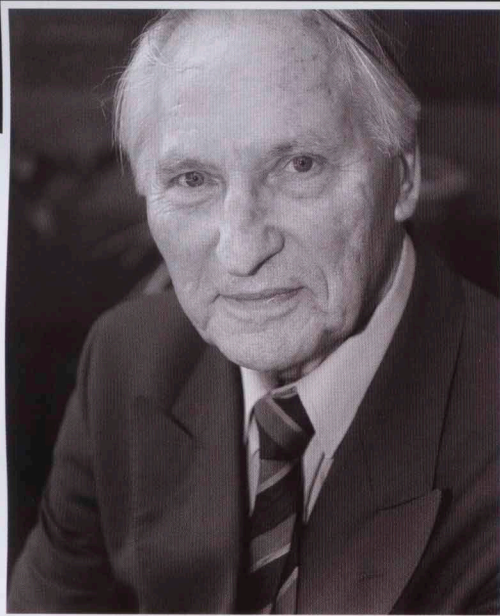


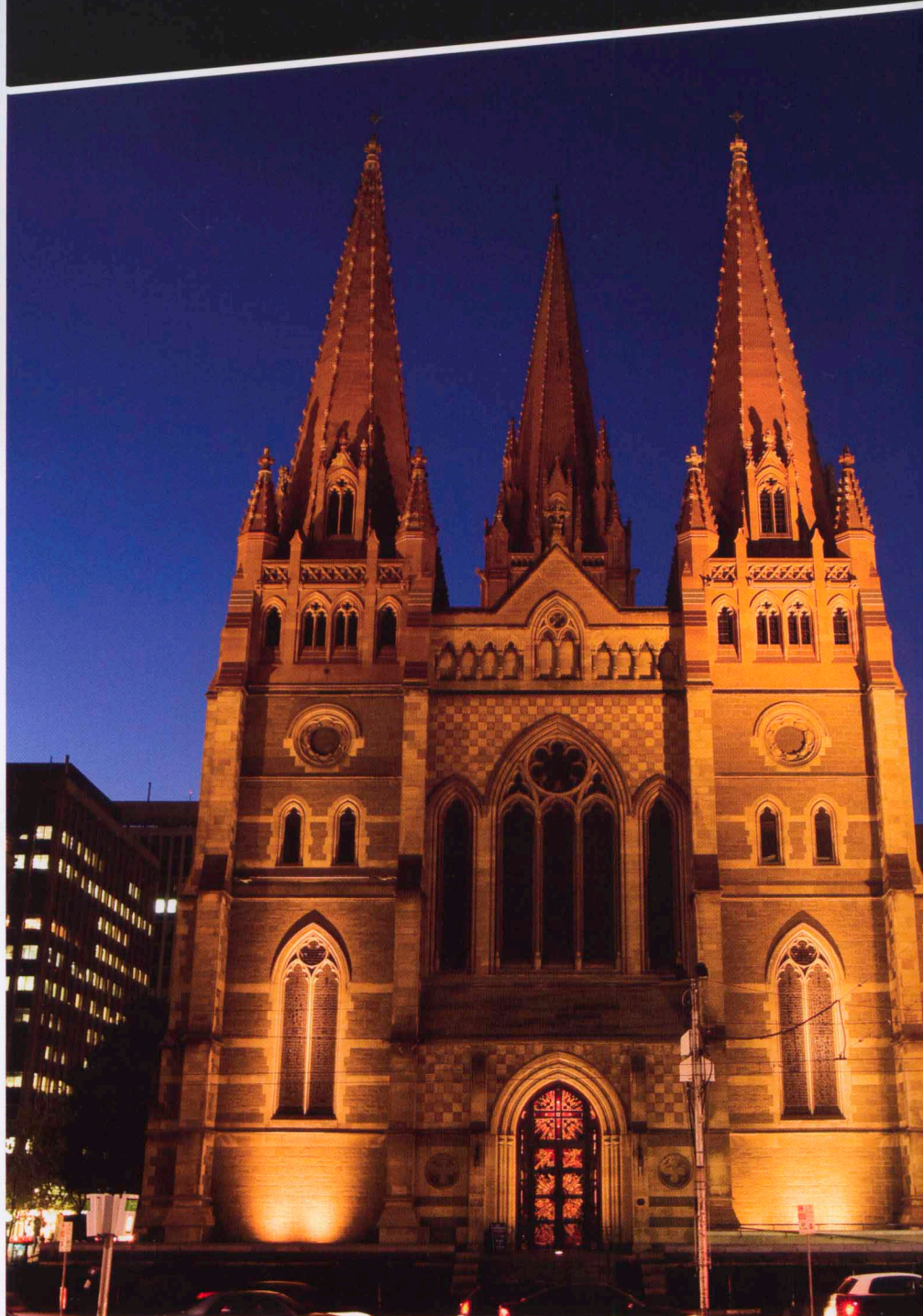
START YOUR OWN MOVEMENT
